Bartending Policies

Century Farm Catering's bartenders are state licensed through the Washington State Liquor Control Board; therefore, all liquor laws will be enforced.

- Must be 21 years of age to be served alcohol
- Must have a current driver's license on hand
- Host/Hostess must purchase a banquet permit for the event https://icb.wa.gov/licensing/banquet-permits
- Most venues will not allow hard alcohol, so if you wish to have hard alcohol at your event, we will need written notice from the venue owner before we bring any hard alcohol out to your event.
- Most venues we work with require you to have event policy insurance. You may
 choose to add this to your homeowner's insurance policy or check out
 www.wedsafe.com. We will need a copy of this to put in your file at least 3 days
 prior to your event.
- All alcohol MUST be at the bar area before event starts. There will be NO alcohol
 purchased and brought into bar area unless prior arrangements have been made
 and a written authorization notice has been agreed upon with host/host, venue
 manager and owner of Century Farm Catering. This is to protect all parties
 involved.
- No alcohol may be consumed before event starts until our licensed bartender from Century Farm Catering is present and serving. As well, as No alcohol may be consumed or served after the event when our licensed bartender has left the event. We will make sure that all alcohol is put away and locked up when we leave event.
- Century Farm Catering reserves the right to close the bar(s) at any time during the event if we feel you as our host/host, the venue or our liquor license may be in jeopardy.

When Choosing an Outdoor Wedding Venue

Things to remember when choosing an outside venue. The warm summer months are perfect for outdoor, garden weddings. Remember to choose a venue that fits your style. It might be a very formal garden or elegant country wedding. Always have a back-up plan in case the unthinkable happens. Weather can be a problem, so somewhere to get inside is always a plus, tents, an event center (barn) or large umbrellas. The venue should have focal points. A gazebo, tall trees, trellis there should also be plenty of shade for those hot days. Consider what the venue provides and how much work you will have to do on your wedding day.

Be sure you know how many events are held per day at the venue, so you are not hurried. Make sure you have appropriate time for photos. Make sure an owner or employee can help coordinate your day even if you have hired a coordinator. Someone who knows the site inside/out can make the day go smoother.

Brides Cottage & Grooms Bunkhouse

We are pleased to offer a Brides Cottage and Grooms Bunkhouse. We work extremely hard to have both in great condition for both Brides and Grooms and their wedding parties.

Due to the fact we have back-to-back weddings we ask that you only allow your Bridal Party to enter these rooms. (Bride, Bridesmaids, Mothers and Flower Girls, Groom, Groomsmen, Fathers and Ring Bearer)

You are welcome to have snacks in your rooms for the wedding party. We do not allow any alcohol in either room unless our bartender is on property and has given out the drinks to the wedding party that are 21 and over. We are a beer and wine venue only, if we find any hard alcohol, you will forfeit all or part of your damage deposit.

NO Red colored drinks of any kind!

Both rooms will be locked after the wedding and opened only if you need to get in. This is for security purposes. Please ask one of our employees to let you in.

Again, we ask all our Brides and Grooms to follow these rules so the next Wedding Party can also enjoy our facilities in perfect condition.

We appreciate your help and anticipate a wonderful event.

I have read and agree with each of these rules:

Information Letter

Booking Fee - A NON-Refundable Booking Fee of \$2500.00 is Required to hold your day. The booking fee payment is non-refundable, even if you decide to cancel your event for any reason
Damage deposit - \$500.00 cash damage deposit, clean-up and overtime deposit are required at least 3 (three)days before your event. If all terms of contracts are met, your damage deposit will be returned no later than 3 (three) days after your event. All or part of your deposit will be kept if we have any confrontation with your guests over alcohol or any other reason. Our staff will not be disrespected in any way
Additional Charges - We provide for up to 250 guests. Any number over 250 is your responsibility. For example, extra chairs, tables, or clean-up. There may be an additional charge for guest numbers over 250 (up to \$500.00)
A Touch of Country will not be held responsible for weather conditions or acts of God. Because we are a working farm, we cannot guarantee how the surrounding fields will look at the time of your event. We will try our best to let you know how they will look at that time of year
Smoking - is highly discouraged but permitted outside in designated smoking area only DUE TO DRY FIELDS AND FIRE DANGER, WE STRICTLY ENFORCE THIS RULE.
Wild birdseed, real flower petals or bubbles are allowed. NO rice, confetti or artificial flower petals are allowed
Children - we do love children; however, A Touch of Country is not well suited for children due to antique furnishings, pond, and outside gardens. The trees are great to look at and for photos but are not to be climbed by children. All children under the age of 10 must always be in the company of an adult. The Brides Cottage and Grooms Bunkhouse are for Wedding Party only.
Music - An especially important part of any event or wedding. You may have a DJ or Live Band the choice is yours. However, the volume must be kept at a level approved by A Touch of Country
Alcohol - Beer and Wine ONLY! No Hard Alcohol. You will need a banquet permit and an event insurance policy. No alcohol will be served without a licensed bartender. If any

ATC staff finds anyone with outside alcohol, the Bar will be shut down for your safety

Water - It is important to have plenty of bottled water, pop, or juice on hand for your guests, especially in the hot summer months						
Clean up - We do the general clean-up. We do ask you to be good examples to your guests and deposit all garbage in the containers provided. Anything belonging to you must be taken with you at the end of your event.						
Rehearsals - One hour is allowed for the rehearsal. Wedding party only! This will have to be scheduled when there is no wedding. Usually on a Thursday. Please be prompt as you will have only one hour, and overtime fees will apply. There may be a rehearsal scheduled after yours, so be prepared and leave promptly after you are finished.						
Pets - Are not allowed on the site. However, if you have a pet you want in your ceremony, we will collaborate with you to make that happen.						
A Touch of Country will not be held responsible for problems due to mechanical failures with any equipment or features on the property. We work as hard as we can to keep everything in good working order, however, sometimes there are unforeseen problems beyond our control that may not be resolved in time for your event						
Event Time - 12pm to 10pm (10pm to 11pm are for clean-up and for wedding party to pick up personal items)						
Catering & Bartending – A Touch of Country has our own inhouse catering; no other caterers are permitted. Please contact Tina Bishop at 509-496-7953 for catering and bartending information.

Guidelines for Damage Deposit

A cash deposit of \$500.00 (dollars) is required 3 days prior to your event. It will be returned within 3 (three) days after your event if A Touch of Country finds no damage or problems!

A Touch of Country holds you responsible for any damage which occurs during your event.

We expect your guests to be courteous and respectful of our property and employees. We also ask you to carry an event insurance policy to cover any unforeseen situations that may occur. This protects you and your guests.

You can find information on event insurance at: www.wedsafe.com

We want your event to be enjoyable and stress free.

Here are a few examples of what the damage deposit can cover. This is not an all-inclusive list. You can and will be held responsible for damages. We can also give your ideas to help ward off any problems. We do not want to keep your damage deposit, but we will if any of these areas become a problem.

- Overtime: Your event has been scheduled for a certain number of hours. Please be aware we charge \$500.00 per hour for overtime (minimum of 1 hour) This will be taken from your damage deposit.
- Any damage to plants, pond or any other part of the grounds or buildings (we want our next event to look as good as your event)
- Tables & Chairs
- Lighting
- Damage to crops in surrounding fields
- Broken Tree Branches, (no tree climbing)
- Smoking is allowed in designated area only. This policy is strictly enforced.
- Alcohol: NO alcohol will be consumed without a Licensed Bartender. A Bartender must serve all Alcohol. Absolutely NO hard alcohol of any kind will be allowed on the premises. The Bar will be closed if we find any alcohol not served by the bartender.
- Children: An adult must always supervise all children. We enjoy children, but we
 do not have the staff to babysit... We do have a list of licensed babysitters that
 are available to watch children at an additional cost.
- Brides Cottage and Grooms Bunkhouse are for wedding party only.

- Working Farm: We are a working farm. Please make sure guests know not to walk into growing crops in surrounding fields. A Touch of Country cannot be held responsible for work going on in surrounding area during your event.
- You are responsible for your guests. We expect your guests to be respectful of our grounds and employees.

Again, this is meant to make your event trouble free and ward off any problems before they start.

Cancelation Policy

If after the signed date of the contract, you should cancel the rental agreement within 30 days of signing, A Touch of Country will require 25% of the remainder of the contract amount + ATC will retain the non-refundable booking fee.

If you should cancel the rental agreement 31 days after signing the contract to 90 days prior to your event, A Touch of Country will require 50% of the remainder of the contract amount + ATC will retain the non-refundable booking fee.

If you should cancel the rental agreement 89-61 days prior to your event, A Touch of Country will require 80% of the remainder of the contract amount + ATC will retain the non-refundable booking fee.

If you should cancel the rental agreement within 60 days to your event, A Touch of Country will require 100% of the remainder of the contract amount + ATC will retain the non-refundable booking fee.

All cancelations must be either e-mailed or sent registered mail so that we have a date stamp to verify the exact date of cancelation. No verbal cancelations will be accepted. All funds are due immediately upon cancelation.
